

The Atacama Desert in northern Chile is famous for its (21) rocky landscape and crystal-clear views of the night sky, making it a magnet for stargazing enthusiasts and even NASA. However, it has also become known for something less glamorous: becoming a dumping ground for (22) clothes due to the rise of fast fashion.

Fast fashion, the rapid production of cheap clothing, has led to a massive increase in clothing waste worldwide. Between 2000 and 2014, global clothing production (23), while consumers started buying 60% more clothes and wearing them for shorter periods. This has resulted in three-fifths of all clothing ending up in landfills or incinerators*within a year of production, causing an environmental and social (24).

The Atacama Desert has earned the nickname "the great fashion garbage patch" because of the large amount of abandoned clothes – with labels from all over the world – piled up across its landscape. These piles stretch for (25) outside Alto Hospicio, a city of 120,000 residents. The harsh sun bleaches the clothes, creating striking scenes of jeans, suit jackets, fake-fur coats, and dress shirts piled high, amid bottles, bags and other trash.

Images of these clothing heaps have shocked many Chileans, who hadn't realized their country was becoming a dumping ground for textiles from (26) nations. The story behind this (27) is not just about passing fashion trends but also about globalization and trade.

Efforts to address the problem focus on (28) off the tap of fast fashion and promoting circular economic practices. By reducing clothing production, encouraging sustainable fashion choices, and finding (29) ways to reuse and (30) textiles, we can work towards lessening the environmental and social impacts of the fast fashion industry, both in Chile and around the world.
