Theory and Ideology (Realism, Liberalism, Nationalism, Marxism, Fascism and Constructivism); contemporary theoretical issues.</p> <p>Lecture 9 【Security】 What is security? deterrence; right of self-defense; alliance; armament; Security dilemma; disarmament; confidence-building measure.</p> <p>Lecture 10 【Security of Japan】 prerequisites for Security of Japan (Art 9 of Constitution, Self-Defense Forces and US-Japan Security arrangements); territorial disputes; Situations in Areas Surrounding Japan (Korean Peninsula, relation between China and Taiwan); other issues.</p> <p>Lecture 11 【International Economy】 What is economy? features of capitalist economy system; Globalization of capital economy and North-South divide; International economy system in the post war era; capital economy's development and enlargement, and its transformation (trade, finance and investment).</p>
